

Refugee Action's guaranteed charity place terms and conditions

By completing an application for a Refugee Action place, you agree to the following terms and conditions. Places are highly in demand and on a first come, first serve basis, so read the following carefully:

1. Refugee Action has a limited number of guaranteed charity places. To apply to run in the 25 Great Manchester Run charity places or the 5 Bath Half Marathon charity places for Refugee Action, you must pledge to pay in a declared sponsorship of £200 to Refugee Action by 30 July 2012.
2. If you are one of the first 25 people to apply for an entry place to the Great Manchester Run or the first 5 people to apply for an entry place to the Bath Half Marathon, you agree to pay a £25 registration fee to Refugee Action and you will not be refunded this fee under any circumstances. If you cancel your Refugee Action place for any reason, your £25 entry fee will be used as a donation to the unrestricted income fund. This fee should be paid immediately as part of your registration form.
3. If you are allocated a Refugee Action charity place then you must agree to only fundraise for Refugee Action. If you set up a Virgin Money Giving or Just Giving page or any other online giving page, 100% of your fundraising must be for Refugee Action.
4. All money raised from the 2012 Great Manchester Run and Bath Half Marathon will be allocated to the unrestricted income fund, so it can be used where most needed.
5. You agree to an interim fundraising deadline of 1 April 2012. You pledge to raise £200 (excluding your entry fee), which should be paid in by 30 July 2012.
6. Any existing regular donations which you make to Refugee Action do not form part of the total raised through sponsorship.
7. Refugee Action will advise you on the recommended way(s) to pay in your sponsorship. This is to ensure that Refugee Action can easily trace funds that you pay in. Refugee Action cannot be liable for cheques lost in the post, or monies paid to Refugee Action in any way other than those that Refugee Action has recommended. The amount that Refugee Action deems to have been raised by you will be the amount that Refugee Action has recognised as having been paid in to its bank account by you.
8. The payment deadline for sponsorship is 30 July 2012. If you need more time to collect sponsorship, please let Refugee Action know in advance of this date. All charities inform the run organisers if someone does not fulfil their pledge.
9. Any monies received by Refugee Action under the Gift Aid scheme (or any other charity tax scheme) as a result of your run, do not count towards the total value of the sponsorship raised.
10. If you decide not to run the Great Manchester Run or the Bath Half Marathon – or decide to run for another charity – you must inform Refugee Action immediately.

11. IMPORTANT: If you sustain a training injury please contact Refugee Action. It is important that you do not take part in the Marathon unless you are completely fit to do so. Deferrals are decided on an individual basis.

12. All Refugee Action guaranteed charity place holders agree that images, audio and video taken on the day may be used by Refugee Action to promote charity runs, events and the charity now and in the future. Furthermore, by applying for Refugee Action's charity place you confirm you are happy for your name and photo to appear in media and/or on the Internet to advertise Refugee Action's part in running events.
